

Directions For Mr Birch's Practice at the Woodland Hospital

M1 North (Loughborough & Leicester), **M1 South** (London & Milton Keynes) **and M6 West** (Coventry & Birmingham)

-From the North (M1) turn onto the A14 at Junction 19.

- From The M6 West, follow the M6 eastbound taking the last Junction (*For the A14*) prior to its merging with the M1 southbound.

- From the South (M1) you cannot turn directly onto the A14 so you will need to leave at Junction 19. Follow the M6 until junction 1 where you turn off and rejoin in the opposite direction. You then leave the M6 at the first junction for the A14.

-Once on the A14 you will travel approximately 13 miles before leaving at Junction 6. There is a signpost marking this turn for the '*Woodland Hospital*' however it is comparably small and at the last minute because the junction is a minor one.

-If you do miss this junction simply leave at Junction 7 for Kettering and Corby, rejoin the A14 in the opposite junction and immediately thereafter there will be access via junction 6 marked for the '*Woodland Hospital*'

Returning onto the A14.

To return towards the M1/M6, turn right at the T-junction as you leave the Hospital road. Follow the tight bend around to the left where it filters back on to the A14. The slip road is quite short so please take care as the traffic moves quickly! Remember that you cannot directly rejoin the M1 towards London so you will need to go to the first junction on the M6 and rejoin in the opposite direction where it will merge into the M1 southbound.

If you wish to continue towards Huntingdon and Cambridge towards the east, turn left at the T-Junction as your leave the Hospital Road. Go back through the underpass and follow the road bending round to the left where it will re join the A14. The slip road is quite short so please take care as the traffic moves quickly!
